Last month we shared information on legal navigation and we'd like to follow that up with some information on legal clinics, like our Talk to a Lawyer Program. A legal clinic is a set event where volunteer attorneys can provide brief advice or services. Often times this is focused on providing guidance to people with legal issues and does not include any representation beyond the clinic.

A legal clinic is like legal urgent care. People in need who don't have an attorney can get needed information on where to go or what to do. The people we see at clinics often fall into two broad areas. The first are those who don't know a thing about the legal system and need help understanding what their issue actually is and possible assurance that finding an attorney for further help is right for them. The second are those who have tried to get help, are unable, and need info to empower them to get an appropriate outcome for their matter. Everyone who uses our clinics would undoubtedly be better off with an attorney representing them, but because of the demand for need and our limited resources we offer clinics as urgent care to try to help all those who would otherwise get no help at all.

In addition to Talk to a Lawyer, VLP administers several other clinics to address common legal needs for those unable to afford legal help and need legal outcomes to lead healthy lives. VLP offers general civil law clinics, family law clinics, housing and eviction clinics, second chance clinics, and more. We provide volunteers with information and support to assist their service. Clinics are great ways to connect with the community or experience other areas of law. 
