Funding is provided to VLP by individual attorneys and paralegals, the Evansville Bar Association, the John Sanders Memorial Evansville Bar Foundation, the Indiana Bar Foundation, as well as corporate gifts and foundation grants.

In the words of the great Scott Wylie, "programs like VLP have suffered severe funding reductions since IOLTA rates collapsed in 2008. VLP presently operates on only 60% of the funding that it had in 2007 before the Great Recession. EBA and EBF support through the years has allowed our local pro bono program remain on of the most vital in the state despite these funding cuts."

Last year, Trivia Night raised over \$9,000 that was split between Legal Aid Society of Evansville and Volunteer Lawyer Program. Let's strive to do even better this year!
