## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

The Old Vanderburgh County Courthouse celebrated its 125<sup>th</sup> anniversary this past month. Located on the site of a former turn-around basin of the Wabash & Erie Canal, the Old Courthouse's cornerstone was laid in 1888 and construction was completed in November 1890.

Although it has not served as a seat of justice for many years, the Old Courthouse continues to shine as a symbol of Evansville and its legal community. Because the history of Evansville law is intertwined with that of the Old Courthouse, this grand structure has a special place in the hearts of Evansville lawyers.

In 1892, soon after masons laid the last stone of the Old Ćourthouse, the Vanderburgh County Law Library was established. By 1910, the Library had a law book collection worth \$6,000. At that time, a committee of local lawyers resolved to organize a bar association whose members would have the privilege of using the Library.

On April 20, 1911, Articles of Incorporation, a Constitution, and Bylaws were approved and the EBA was born. Its first President was Albert W. Funkhouser. Its mission was "to promote the study and development of law as a science; to elevate and maintain the dignity of the profession; to cultivate social intercourse among its members; and to increase its usefulness in promoting the due administration of justice."

Since 1911, the EBA and affiliate organizations have doggedly pursued this mission through efforts such as the establishment of the Legal Aid Society of Evansville, our partnership with the Volunteer Lawyer

Program of Southwest Indiana, and the philanthropy of the Evansville Bar Foundation.

Through the years, Evansville lawyers have distinguished themselves in many ways. We count former Chief Justice of Indiana Randall Shepard among our ranks. Our Association has also produced seven Presidents of the Indiana State Bar Association, beginning with Henry Walker in 1928 and the most recent being Paul Arnold in 1990.

Not all of our history has been honorable. In 1919, the EBA vigorously opposed the admission of an African-American lawyer, Ernest Tidrington. The first African-American detective in the Evansville Police Department, Tidrington eventually won admission to the bar after the EBA failed to appear at a hearing on Tidrington's character, but the EBA never admitted Tidrington as a member of the Association. Today, greater diversity is a foremost goal of our Association as we strive to achieve a membership that reflects the Evansville community.

Through the highs and lows, a rich tapestry of our Association's history has been woven. That history is on display in the EBA's Legal History Center in the Old Courthouse. Creation of the Legal History Center was part of the Randall T. Shepard Courtroom renovation project undertaken by the EBA as part of our 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration in 2011.

The Legal History Center is a treasure trove of information stretching back to the earliest days of Evansville's founding. You can view a photograph of the 1910 lawyers' baseball team that beat the doctors' team by a score of 16 to 8. You can learn how, during World War II, the EBA helped its members cope with tire and gas rationing by coordinating travel to adjoining counties. And, partaking of the Legal History Center's best feature, you can view videos of senior EBA members recounting stories of the practice of law from days gone by.

Many of us walk right by the Legal History Center on our way to EBA events like Law Day and memorial services. The next time you find yourself in the Old Courthouse, stop by the Legal History Center to connect with generations past and learn more about the foundation upon which our legal community is built.

## **News From the EBA Board of Directors**

- The Board reviewed dues pricing from other Indiana Bar Associations, as well as the EBA financials and voted to have no membership dues increases for 2016 dues.
